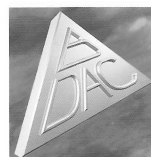

Size of Work

2D work (paintings, photographs etc) must be no larger than 340mm x 400mm when framed. Anything larger will not be accepted.

3D work (ceramics, sculpture, crafts etc) must fit inside a 400mm cube.

All 2D works should be fitted with two mirror plates halfway up each side without any other fixing or string attached. Clip frames will not be accepted. 2D works without mirror plates will not be accepted. All works must have labels; one fixed to the rear of a work and a tie on label to hang over the front. Both labels to give name, address, title of work, medium and price or NFS if not for sale.

SUBMISSION OF WORK

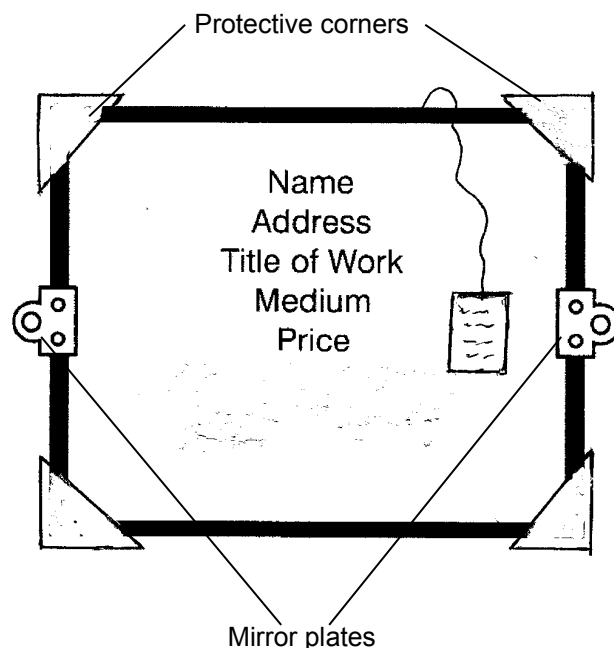
Entry is open to all artists and crafts people, 16 years or over, living, working or studying in East Staffordshire or within a 10-mile radius of Burton upon Trent. **Work must be submitted to the Brewhouse on Friday 14th and Saturday 15th March between 10am and 3pm.**

SELECTION OF WORK

The decision of the selector on each work submitted will be final. Notice of the decision will be posted to the artist by Thursday 27th March 2008. Works selected will be available for collection on Tuesday 20th May, 10am-3pm. All works not claimed by 4pm will be disposed of.

SALE OF WORKS

The Brewhouse will negotiate sales at the price stated by the artist on the entry form. Prices to include mount and frame unless otherwise stated. A commission of 30% will be charge. A sold sticker will be placed by the work. Artists will be notified and cheques will be issued no later than 28 days after the end of the exhibition. All works must remain hung until the close of the exhibition.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Each artist may submit a maximum of 2 works. The size of 2D work is limited to 340mm x 400mm, including the frame. 3D work must fit inside a 400mm cube.

- A non-returnable submission fee of £2.00 per work must be paid on submission. Cheques to be made payable to Burton and District Arts Council. Please bring the completed entry form and a first class stamped self-addressed envelope.
- The title, medium and price* of each work together with the artists name must be entered on a tie-on label, which should be attached to the work. The string should be long enough to hang over the front of the work, and the information should be repeated on a stick-on label on the back of the work.

*Prices should include the frame. Prices cannot be advertised as negotiable or altered during the exhibition. Work not for sale should be marked N.F.S. on this form and on the work. A commission of 30% will be charged on all sales including unselected works sold at the private view. A sold sticker will be placed by the work. Artists will be notified and cheques issued no later than 28 days after the exhibition ends. All selected work must remain hung until the close of the exhibition.

- All frames should be sturdy and must be fitted with mirror plates halfway up each side (see diagram), pictures without mirror plated will not be accepted. No other fixing must be attached. Clip frame will not be accepted. Unframed 2D work should be battened.
- All 2D work should be packed with padded corner protection, light disposable packing may protect fragile works.
- All submissions should be presented to a high standard.
- Works previously exhibited in any exhibition organised by BADAC or the Brewhouse will not be accepted.
- Entry is open to all artists and craftspeople, 16 years and over, living, working or studying in east Staffordshire or within a 10-mile radius of Burton upon Trent.
- Whilst every precaution is taken to ensure the safety of artwork, ESBC can offer a maximum of £1000 per artwork to artists who exhibit.
- The decision of the selector on each work submitted is final. Notice of the decision will be posted by Thursday 27th March 2008.
